In Memoriam: HCFCU Board Chairman, Larry T. Dehnert

Larry T. Dehnert, Chairman of the Harris County Federal Credit Union Board of Directors, passed away on May 8, 2013, at the age of 63.



Larry's service to the credit union spans three decades and includes almost 20 years as Board Chairman. While working with the Harris County District Attorney's Office, Larry made time to volunteer for HCFCU, first with the Credit Committee and then the Board of Directors. He joined the Board in 1984, overseeing strong asset growth and increased membership as well as the relocation of the credit union to its current location.

He was a man of great integrity who approached his responsibilities as Chair with commitment and vision. He was passionate about the credit union. He would often recall its humble beginnings and how it has grown into a full service financial institution serving more than 14,000 members.

Edward Gardner, current Chairman, who has known Larry for the last 20 years, said "he was a dedicated volunteer who always put member service first. It was a pleasure serving on the credit union board with him. He will be dearly missed." Larry's commitment was an inspiration to the staff and his leadership on the board will be a lasting legacy.
